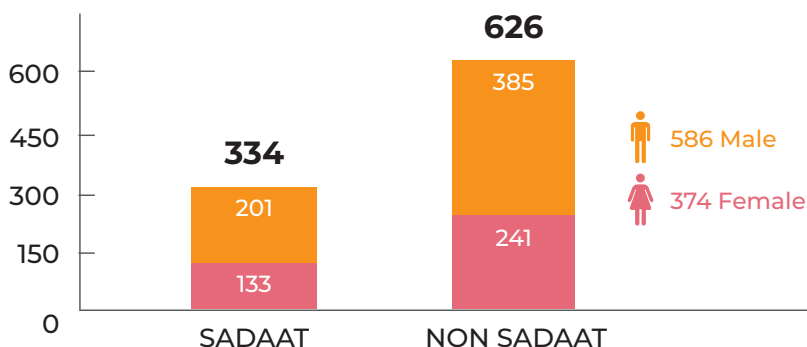
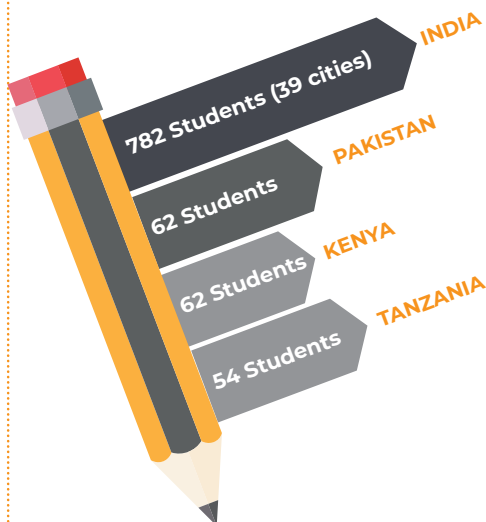

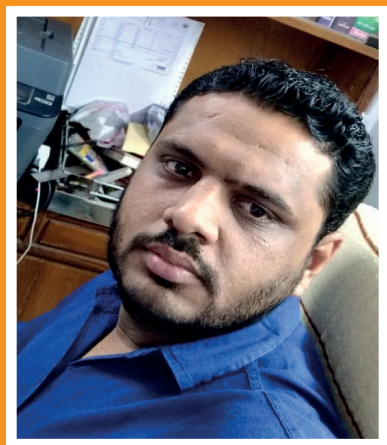
OUR STUDENTS

My father was not capable of paying my school fees. While in school I used to odd jobs to cover my daily expenses. I used to sell soda, fruits, kites and fire crackers in the local market. Those days I used to feel that this is how I will spend my life because I could never gather fees for education.

Alhamdulillah HEWST and WF became means of paying my fees and today I am a successful motivational speaker having conducted almost 200 seminars throughout Gujarat. I have been awarded 17 awards. I run Alfa Academy which has 187 students and plan to be a donor in the future to support students via HEWST and WF so that students from less privilege also get an opportunity to be successful in life."



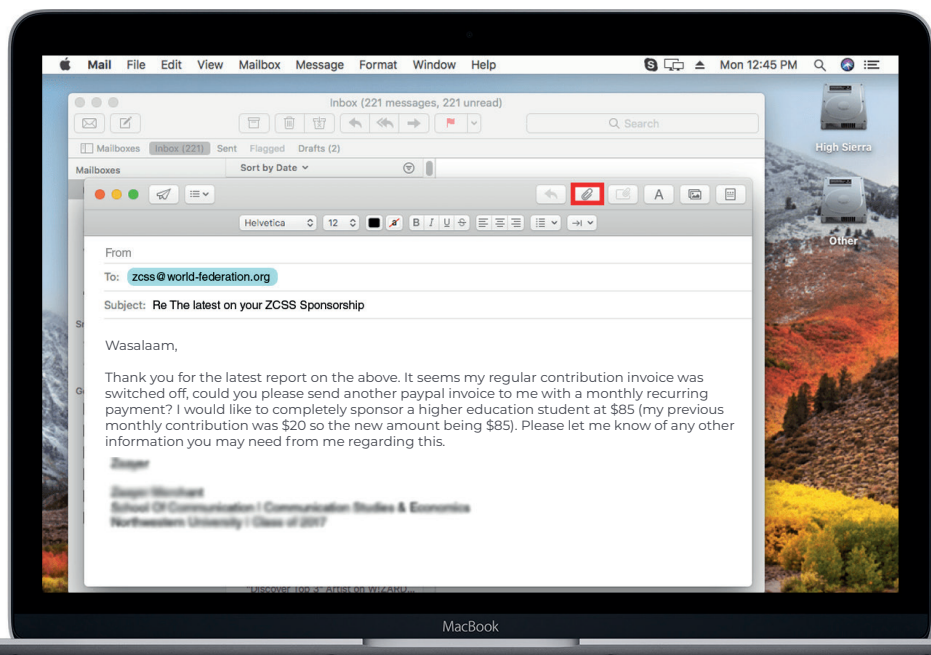
Sohil Virani - A Success Story

Sohil cleared his class 10 in 2005 and started working in a general store as a helper and was paid GBP 15 per month. He then started to learn MS Office and Accounts with the support of a local agency. He then got a job at an accountant's firm and got paid GBP 45 per month. His journey with ZCSS began in 2008 when he appeared for class 12.

He then went ahead to clear the accountant's CPT Examination which resulted in an increment in salary to GBP 90. He did not stop there, with continuous hard work and support

from ZCSS he further proceeded to take up chartered accountant's IPCC and cleared it in 2011. With the gained work experience and hard work he now runs a successful business earning several hundred pounds per month.

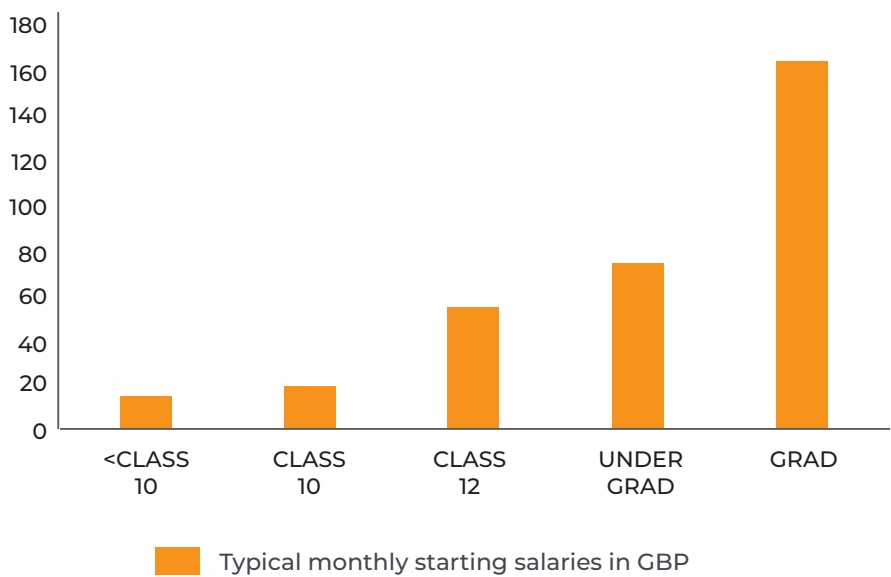

DID YOU KNOW?

- For every one student we support, we have to turn away another. We are only able to meet 50% of the current requirement in Higher Education Sponsorship.
- Sponsored students are able to attain higher qualifications and take up the latest specialised courses as they are able to study uninterrupted for the duration of their courses. Current students are undertaking a wide variety of courses from Diplomas and degrees including BSc, MBA, MBBS, and PhD.
- In India, a class 10 pass gets a starting salary of barely GBP 20 per month whereas a Higher Education Graduate can earn GBP 165 per month. It is YOU who has empowered them!
- Some of your sponsored children are earning over GBP 2,000 per month!
- After successfully completing higher education studies, families are able to move out of Jamaat-sponsored homes and move into their own homes.
