The Mohsin & Fauzia Jaffer Foundation's generous support in providing educational opportunities and vocational training to marginalised students through the Elimu Bora Sponsorship Scheme and Economic Upliftment Program through tailoring is making a tangible difference in the lives of underprivileged children and women, empowering them with the tools they need to build a brighter future.

The Elimu Bora Sponsorship Scheme by WF-AID aims to break the cycle of poverty through education and the support of vocational alternatives for financially disadvantaged students. Currently, we have committed to supporting 10 students in Kenya with a USD \$27,034 investment over several years, focusing on gender equity (60% female). While secondary students represent 70% of beneficiaries, 57.5% of funding goes to higher education. The average investment per student is USD \$2,703, with costs varying based on education level. In 2024, the students achieved an average attendance rate of 99% and an average grade of a C+.

WF-AID's Microfinance Program in Kenya empowers women through a two-year vocational training in tailoring, dressmaking, and design. Graduates either find employment or start their own businesses. The program promotes business sustainability and timely loan repayments. The Mohsin & Fauzia Jaffer Foundation has committed to funding the construction of two classes as well as equipment and running costs for two years at USD \$61,900, and an additional USD \$10,930 for equipment and running costs of a third class, bringing the total project cost to USD \$72,830.

At the end of 2024, the construction of the two classes in Bahakanda & Nzavoni have been completed. This brings the total spent so far to USD \$36,427.
