As of Q4 2024, **USD \$81,132.75 of** your donation has been utilised to procure much-needed surgical equipment over the period 2021–2024. This equipment has significantly improved the centre's capacity to perform critical eye surgeries. With a remaining Balace of **USD \$13,867.25.**

Milestones & Successes

Over the past few years, the number of patients seeking KSI Charitable Eye Centre (KSI) optical services has dramatically increased, reflecting a growing need and a deep trust in the care.

In 2022, KSI treated **21,739 patients**. This number soared to **37,073 in 2023**. In **2024**, treated **47,556 patients**. The surgical interventions have similarly increased, with **873** surgeries performed in **2022**, **1,943 in 2023**, and **2,240 in 2024**. These numbers signify not only the rising demand for eye care but also the ability to meet these needs effectively. Most beneficiaries come from poor backgrounds, where KSI assists with subsidising funding for treatment.

However, there is still much work to be done. Many individuals are in urgent need of treatments for conditions such as cataracts and glaucoma. Your generous support has helped continue KSI's services, ensuring that no one in need of eye care is left untreated.
