INTRODUCTION

In many impoverished families, arranging marriages for daughters becomes an overwhelming challenge due to the societal expectation of providing dowry, leaving countless young women and their parents in distress. This project aims to alleviate this burden by offering financial assistance and essential household items to underprivileged couples, enabling them to begin their married lives with dignity.

Focused on regions severely affected by poverty, such as Dera Ismail Khan, Mianwali, Jampur, Kot Addu, Rajanpur, Layyah, Muzaffargarh, Shikarpur and Naushahro Feroze, the initiative supported 260 couples this year. Building on the success of previous efforts, the program covered wedding expenses and provided necessities, including clothing, utensils, bedding, fans, irons, blankets, and religious books like the Holy Qur'an and Nahjul Balagha. By easing the financial strain on families, this initiative not only addressed pressing socio-economic issues but also empowered couples to embark on a stable and dignified married life.






HOW YOUR DONATION WAS SPENT

BENEFICIARY STORY - 1

Name: Rizwana Bibi

Location: Mari Indus, District Mianwali, Punjab.

Ali Khan, a poor labourer, had spent years worrying about his daughter Rizwana Bibi's marriage, as his small earnings barely covered the family's daily needs. When he heard about the collective marriage programme, supported by The World Federation and the Mohsin & Fauzia Jaffer Foundation, he applied, hoping for help.

After verification by community members, Rizwana Bibi was selected. On October 27, 2024, her wedding took place at Al-Fajar Institute in Mari Indus, Mianwali. She received essential household items to start her new life, and the event ended with a Walima event.

With tears of joy, Ali thanked the organizers for helping him fulfil his dream of a respectful and dignified wedding for his daughter.

BENEFICIARY STORY - 2

Name: Bano Bibi

Location: Shikarpur, Sindh.

Razia Begum, a widow in Shikarpur, struggled to raise her children after her husband's untimely death. Her biggest worry was her daughter Bano's wedding, as her earnings from stitching clothes were barely enough to sustain the family.

When Razia heard about a collective marriage programme supported by The World Federation and the Mohsin & Fauzia Jaffer Foundation, she applied with hope. After verification, Bano was selected, and her wedding was held in October 2024. The organizers provided household essentials to help her start her new life.

"This kindness has given my daughter a dignified start," said Razia, her voice filled with gratitude. "I could never have done this on my own."
