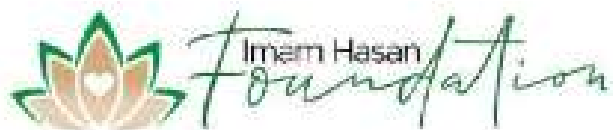

Fidyah, Fitrah & Kaffarah

Fidyah, Fitrah, and Kaffarah are charitable dues given in the form of staple foods (or essential needs, for Fitrah) to the fuqarā—those lacking basic daily necessities. Priority is placed on supporting families and vulnerable individuals within one's own community. These obligations require fixed amounts of staple food, measured in mudds and sā's, to provide for those in need.

LEBANON EMERGENCY

As part of our commitment to vulnerable families in Lebanon. WF-AID has directed funds towards prefabricated housing, medical equipment, assistive devices, and essential school supplies.

WF-AID in partnership with Imam Hasan Foundation, is building 200 prefabricated housing units. These efforts will continue to provide immediate support to families in rebuilding stability and security for the future.

PAKISTAN FLOOD RELIEF

The recent floods in August 2025 have devastated businesses, farmlands, and homes, leaving families—already struggling—facing even greater hardship. So far, we have managed to support efforts in Gilgit Baltistan and Punjab with a distributed amount of over £75,000 supporting 30,000+ individuals with Food Packs, Mosquitoes nets and repellents, tents, blankets and medicine.

Elimu Bora Child Sponsorship Scheme

WF-AID, in partnership with WF-Education, continues to support the Elimu Bora Sponsorship Programme to break the cycle of poverty by enabling access to education and vocational pathways for financially disadvantaged students. Currently, WF-AID sponsors 10 students in Kenya, with a total project commitment of £5,800 since 2024, of which £4,020 has been utilised.

Dar Al-Zahra School, Iraq

WF-AID provided £42,600 in support to Dar Al-Zahra School in Iraq to cover essential running costs, ensuring the school and its teachers can continue delivering quality education to students in a stable and sustainable learning environment.

ECONOMIC UPLIFTMENT & ORPHANS AND WIDOWS

Economic Upliftment

WF-AID also contributed over **£93,000** towards the construction of Hawza dormitory, teachers house, borewell in the surrounding area, mosque, nursery classes and madrasah these new buildings have now become vital not only for religious advancement but also expanding humanitarian outreach and social welfare activities.



Orphans & Widows

Often due to the loss of family members during war, natural disasters, poverty, and disease, it leads to widows and orphans needing access to food, healthcare, shelter, and emotional support. Total value disbursed across India and Pakistan was over **£50,000**, providing ongoing support to **110 orphans and 100 widows/orphaned families**

HEALTH & MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

In 2025, WF-AID continues to provide critical healthcare assistance to underprivileged communities. By improving access to essential medical care, cataract/glaucoma treatment, life-saving treatments, emergency support, hospital expansion projects, diagnosis equipment maintenance, staff salaries and medication support.

HOUSING PROJECTS

WF-AID is supporting vulnerable families through the delivery of 94 flats at the Mulla Asghar Housing Complex in Palghar, India.



WF-AID is providing housing and utilities support in Nepal

WF-AID is delivering 10 permanent homes for widows in Pakistan (supporting 10 widow families)



WF-AID is progressing the Ahmedabad Girls Hostel and Community Centre in Ahmedabad, India, expected to benefit approximately 350-500 individuals.

WF-AID is advancing 22 rent-to-own flats in Bhavnagar, India.



WF-AID has funded furnishing improvements at Nagalpur Masjid (carpets and doors)

A total of £868,000+ has been remitted since the beginning of 2025 for the continuation of the above-mentioned projects, benefitting **1,800+ beneficiaries**

FOOD & FINANCIAL AID AND COLLECTIVE MARRIAGES

Food & Financial Aid

WF-AID provides comprehensive assistance to vulnerable widows, orphans, and low-income families across multiple districts, including 6-month staple food parcels, monthly rations, financial support for essential expenses, and medical assistance. These initiatives benefited **1,654 individuals**, with a total value of **£60,000+**, ensuring food security, healthcare access, and support for basic living costs.

Collective Marriages

Since 2021, WF-AID has been implementing the Collective Marriage program in Pakistan to help hundreds of Shia Couples to marry dignity and respect. **624 couples** have gotten married under this program so far. In 2025, WF-AID has further allocated over **£150,000** towards the collective marriage program to support **460 couples** from underprivileged communities in Punjab, Sindh and KPK to begin their married life with utmost dignity and respect. This initiative is expected to be implemented in November/December 2025.
